

The Commissioners of the Warner Village Water District, at their meeting on November 28, 2016, voted to support nomination of the Warner River under the State's Rivers Management and Protection Program. As you know the District relies for its water supply on wells located near the Warner River that draw water from the aquifer beneath and connected to the river. The Commissioners are acutely aware of the potential for upstream land uses and practices to harm the quality of the river water and its aquifer through the release of chemicals and other contaminants.

We believe that designation of the Warner River under RSA 483 and the subsequent formation of a regional Local Advisory Committee to review development and other proposals requiring local and/or State approval will provide an additional level of scrutiny and comment that may prove significant in protecting the quality of this natural resource.
